I recently read a book by C.S. Lewis titled "The Screwtape Letters." It was first published in 1942. It is a fictional series of letters from a senior demon, Screwtape, to his nephew, Wormwood. Wormwood is trying to secure the eternal damnation of a young man living in Great Britain and his Uncle Screwtape is offering advice on how to succeed in preventing this un-named man from being saved. Spoiler alert: they fail.

As Christians, we know that God desires to be deeply involved in all aspects of our lives, but sometimes it's easy to forget that Satan basically wants the same thing. Once a person has repented of their sins and asked

Jesus to save them, Satan knows he can't ever change that, so his goal becomes to render that person an ineffective Christian.

He probably doesn't care if you or I go to church every Sunday, but it bothers him greatly when we live out our Christianity in public.

I found the book, albeit fiction, to be useful in understanding Satan's strategy and tactics. Ephesians 6:11-18 is a familiar passage that instructs us to put on the whole armor of God. We need that armor because Satan is always looking for an opportunity to attack (I Peter 5:8), and to cripple our work for the Lord. When we repel Satan's efforts, in my opinion, there is rejoicing in Heaven. I don't think I've ever really looked at it like this before, but a worthwhile goal for any Christian would be to aggravate and annoy Satan every day.
